

Preventive Diplomacy Academy

The UNRCCA Preventive Diplomacy Academy (PDA) is an annual 10-month-long educational platform for young people from Central Asia and Afghanistan aimed at building connections with the region's youth, creating a culture of conflict prevention, in line with UNSC Resolutions 2250, 2419, and 2535 on YPS and the UN Youth Agenda.

Tasks

- Raise awareness of UN peace and security activities and the UN Youth Strategy.
- Broaden the horizons and lay the foundations for a culture of preventive diplomacy.
- Promote cultural sensitivity and respect.
- Advocate for the importance of dialogue, partnership and cooperation in conflict prevention.
- Develop leadership skills to motivate an active life position.

Central Asian Deputy Foreign Ministers Meeting

Each year, the ten best students are selected to have a unique opportunity to participate in the annual Deputy Foreign Ministers meeting and address the most pressing issues of their generation in an open dialogue with government representatives. Young men and women join this unique platform to voice their concerns and propose concrete solutions to the challenges that young people consider crucial for the peaceful development of their countries.
